The Victoria Civilian Police Academy Alumni Association is not a part of the Victoria Police Department, but operates as a stand-alone organization of citizens. The CPAAA is a nonprofit 501c3 organization. We are not bonded nor do we work as security guards.

Each year our organization awards several scholarships to either college students who are going to pursue a degree in justice or college students who are the children or spouse of a peace office in Victoria County. Each year we award scholarships in amounts ranging from \$500 to \$1,000.

Our services are free, but donations to the CPAAA Scholarship Fund are graciously accepted.

- Parking on private property or parking lots
- Helping with parades
- Assisting with taking tickets at the door or gate of any event
- Help work booths at events or celebrations
- Child fingerprinting

We will review your application at our Executive Board meeting, the first Monday of the month, and if approved will present it at our monthly meeting (which is the third Tuesday of the month) in order to have volunteers sign up.
