Order Terminating Additional Hygiene Measures

Summary: *This terminates the Mayor's July 1, 2020 executive order, which previously required facial coverings.*

Whereas Greg Abbott, Governor of the State of Texas, issued Executive Order GA-29 on July 2, 2020, ("EO-GA-29"), which ordered that every Texan shall wear a face covering over the nose and mouth whenever it is not feasible to maintain six feet of social distancing, and provided for numerous exceptions; and

Whereas, I, Rawley McCoy, Mayor of the City of Victoria, on July 1, 2020, issued an executive order requiring face coverings in the City of Victoria under similar, but not identical situations; and

Whereas it is important that citizens of the City of Victoria have clarity regarding which face-covering orders apply to them, and in which situations;

Now therefore, I, Rawley McCoy, Mayor of the City of Victoria, Texas, acting under the authority granted to me by Chapter 122 of the Health and Safety Code, Chapter 7 of the City of Victoria Code of Ordinances, and Chapter 418 of the Texas Government Code, do hereby find and order:

1. That this Order terminates the Executive Order that I executed on July 1, 2020.
2. That this **ORDER** shall take effect at 12:01 p.m. on July 3, 2020.
